This prohibition begins on the date you begin to actively support or oppose an application before LAFCO and continues until three months after a final decision is rendered by LAFCO. No Commissioner or Alternate may solicit or accept a campaign contribution of \$250 or more from you or your agent during this period if the Commission or Alternate knows or has reasons to know that you will participate in the proceedings. If you or your agent have made a contribution of \$250 or more to any Commissioner or Alternate during the 12 months preceding the decision, that Commissioner or Alternate must disqualify him or herself from the decision. However, disqualification is not required if the Commissioner or Alternate returns the campaign contribution within thirty (30) days of learning both about the contribution and the fact that you are a participant in the proceedings.

If you wish to speak on an agenda item, green speaker cards are provided near the back wall of the Chambers. The cards must be completed and returned to the Commission's Clerk. The Commission limits speaker comments to three (3) minutes. The Commission may extend the time as necessary.
