SUBJECT: **FY 16/17 Work Plan Status Report**

RECOMMENDATION: The Commission receive and file the update on the work plan for FY 16/17.

BACKGROUND:

Each year the Commission adopts a work plan that includes anticipated applications as well as other administrative activities. The work plan is used in estimating fee revenues for the annual budget.

DISCUSSION:

These last two months staff focused on municipal service reviews for the City of Benicia and the sanitation districts, Fairfield-Suisun Sewer District and Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District. Staff worked with the City of Benicia to complete the draft that will be before the Commission in December. As with Suisun City staff offered to prepare all but the facilities and financial sections of the MSR. Those two sections rely on city staff to provide information while the other sections of the MSR can be completed through searching the internet along with documents provided by the city. The purpose of this method was to reduce the time for city staff yet complete the MSR in a reasonable amount of time.

Staff also discussed updating the MSR for the City of Rio Vista. Staff will be meeting with city staff to review the process and initiate the study.

In August staff issued an RFP for the upcoming audit. The County Auditor's office had completed the previous two audits. The RFP was sent to six CPA firms that have experience auditing municipal governments and LAFCOs as well as the County Auditor. Responses were due September 30 and a recommendation will be made to the Commission to enter into a contract with the best qualified respondent.

Staff continues to work with CALAFCO. Most recently the Executive Officer was added to the workgroup that will produce a white paper on agricultural preservation policies.

In addition, through consultation with city planning staff, a couple projects in the work plan were no longer under consideration as potential annexation areas. They include the Goodyear Road annexation and the North Dixon Annexation. They were moved to the "No longer being considered" section of the work plan.
