SUBJECT: PROPOSED WORK PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends the Commission review and adopt, or adopt with modifications, the work program for fiscal year 2017-2018.

### **BACKGROUND:**

On April 10 the Commission received the proposed work program and budget for the upcoming fiscal year. The Commission directed staff to include the work program at their next meeting.

#### Discussion:

The amended work program includes additional anticipated proposals from the cities of Vacaville and Dixon. It is divided into three categories: external activities, internal administration, and outreach and external relations.

- 1) **External Activities** projects that the LAFCO is statutorily required to carry out; activities include municipal service reviews, sphere of influence updates, and changes of organization and reorganization proposals. External activities also include Commission initiated projects that are discretionary, but support statutory requirements.
- 2) **Internal Administration** projects to improve the internal operations with goals of streamlining processes to reduce the cost of operating LAFCO.
- 3) Outreach and External Relations establish and improve working relationship with the cities, county, and special districts at the staff and board/council level; identify opportunities to increase the value of LAFCO in its interactions with agencies. Collaborate with other LAFCOs and participate in CALAFCO advance training opportunities.

### 3) Outreach and External Relations

Establish and improve collaborative relationship with the cities, county, and special districts at the staff and board/council level. This would include introducing the new Executive Officer to agency staff and officials, seeking an understanding of agency procedures as they interact with LAFCO; identifying and implementing changes to improve communication. For example LAFCO staff sought and received clarification from the CAO for directing the various notices that LAFCO must send to ensure the most appropriate individual or department is the recipient. Numerous other opportunities for improving efficiency and collaboration are possible.

Enhance LAFCO's website to provide an opportunity to educate other agencies and the public on LAFCO's projects, as well as enhance agency transparency. Enhancing the website will improve accessibility and transparency for recordings of LAFCO meetings and final approval documents to be available on the web page.

Continue to collaborate with other LAFCOs and participate in CALAFCO training opportunities. The new Executive Officer will be relying heavily on the resources of CALAFCO and his or her colleagues in the organization.
